Course Contents

 This course deals briefly with the religious, social, political and economic life of Arab Community before Islam, and then it elaborates on the priorities of Arabic poetry and its environment, purposes, poem construction and some literary issues and phenomena such as novels, blogging, plagiarism, odes, and the art of prose and its masters. It also explores the analysis of selected texts of poetry and prose of the most famous writers of that age
