FRENCH Discourse Analysis 3 Credits FREN-4313 Analyse du Discours Français This course is intended to bring the students to advanced consciousness of the specific discourse level in language and communication phenomena, and to make them able to deal with it. Particularly, the aim is to give the students the means to deal with French composition tasks. The first side of the course will focus on a short-type-texts composition (like formal correspondance), in order to introduce the students to a wider personal performance. The second side will focus on analyzing, practicing argumentative speech in order to provide the students with the capacity to reach full comprehension of it. Both sides are made up of theoretical enlightenment and supervised practical work. Prerequisites: a score of 60 % for the first, second and third level subjects.
